Regulatory update: Lesotho Exemption Permits (LEP)



Khulani Labour acknowledges the Minister of Home Affairs' directive extending the validity of Lesotho Exemption Permits (LEPs). **Existing LEPs are deemed valid for an additional 18 months, extending their validity until 28 May 2027.** This extension provides certainty while consultations continue on longer-term immigration solutions. Khulani Labour remains committed to full compliance with all labour and immigration regulations and continues to manage our workforce accordingly.
